## Evaluation

## I. Summary of Course Evaluation

Total number of answers: 12
Short summary of the result: Unfortunately, only $20 \%$ took the course evaluation, which is only half of last time. That could be because the majority of the students were exchange students. The ongoing pandemic could also have influenced the response rate (see below).

There were still too many students who spent too little time on the course, which is going at half speed. $33 \%$ worked a maximum of 12 hours a week, which was a reduction from the $45 \%$ last time, but $8 \%$ worked more than 20 hours a week on the course. It was $67 \%$ who felt that they had been relatively active on the course, which was less than last time, and $92 \%$ thought it had been a reasonable workload.

It was $67 \%$ who thought that the prerequisites were sufficient for the course, $55 \%$ thought the course worked well, and $73 \%$ thought it was clear what was expected of them. About $82 \%$ felt that the literature helped and $91 \%$ that the exercises helped. It was $83 \%$ that felt that the exam matched the content and level of the course. These percentages were less than the last time, which may be a consequence of the ongoing pandemic (see below).

A clear majority ( $73 \%$ ) thought that the course has made them more confident in tackling unfamiliar problems but only $58 \%$ in working in groups which was less than last time. Almost everyone ( $92 \%$ ) thought that the course had increased their reading and writing skills, but only $67 \%$ their verbal skills, which is about the same as last time.
$73 \%$ were satisfied with the quality of the course, about the same as last time.

## II. Evaluation of changes since last course

The biggest change since the last course was the developing pandemic situation, which meant that all the teaching went online after 26 November.

## III. Proposed changes to the next course

There were no suggestions for changes from the students.
