## Summary of student's answers:

The teaching consists of lectures. Theoretical home assignments and computer exercises are a central part of the course. These assignments should be solved in smaller groups and reports can be handed in for feedback during the course. The assignments are not compulsory, but they are recommended as preparation for the oral examination at the end of the course. The course is taught together with FMNN01 at LTH. The course evaluation there is done separately.

## Changes from the previous course realisation:

Compared to the previous course realisation, the biggest change was that Claus Führer retired and was replaced by Andreas Langer, who has now given the course for the first time.
